Seekonk Water Users

PHASE 3

Outdoor Water Management Program


Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 21G, authorizes the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to regulate the quantity of water withdrawn from surface and ground water systems. Seekonk is a ground water system. Under this law Seekonk is allowed to withdraw a daily average of 1.71 million gallons per day (MGD) equating to 624.15 million gallons per year (MGY). Dependent on weather conditions, Seekonk's annual withdrawal can exceed 500.0 MGY. By imposing the "Annual Water Management Program" Seekonk can abide by the established DEP requirements.

Effective August 11th to September 30th, the Seekonk Water District has implemented PHASE 3 of their "Water Management Program. Phase 3 is a Total Ban of use of outdoor water. No outdoor water usage. Strict enforcement will be implemented. Water District personnel and Police Department personnel will issue violation notices. Fines will be levied and water shut-off on the properties will take place where disregard for the BAN is apparent.


Because this phase is mandatory, violators will be subject to fines and water shut-off as follows:

| • Fourth Offense | Termination of water until the matter of continued violation is resolved |


